**Moorestown Fire District No. 2**  
**2015 Election Information**

The annual election for the voters of Fire District No. 2 to approve the 2015 Annual Budget and elect two Fire Commissioners will be held on Saturday, February 21, 2015 from 2:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the Lenola Fire House located at 229 N. Lenola Road.

Voters will be asked to approve a \$715,523.00 tax levy that is part of a \$1,341,818.00 budget. The proposed amount to be raised by taxation remained flat compared to 2014 which is within the 2% property tax levy cap. The proposed budget will result in a 3/10 of a cent decrease in the tax rate lowering the rate to 8.3 cents per \$100.00 assessed valuation. Residents in the average assessed home of \$445,300.00 will pay \$371.38 in fire taxes in 2015. This is an \$11.58 decrease from 2014.

The budget is subject to final adoption upon voter approval.

The registered voters of the Fire District will be asked to elect two individuals to membership for a three-year term on the Board of Fire Commissioners. Incumbents Lawrence F. Niedermayer Sr. and William J. Wesolowski and newcomer Daniel B. Sheilds are running for two three-year terms.

In addition, voters will be asked to approve the repaving of the front and side parking lots of the Lenola Volunteer Fire Station at a cost not to exceed Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00). Funding will be provided from unrestricted reserve fund balance.

Voters will also be asked to approve the purchase of a replacement command vehicle for the Fire Chief for an amount not to exceed Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00). Funding will be provided from unrestricted reserve fund balance.
