**NOTICE TO PERSONS
WANTING MAIL-IN BALLOTS**

If you are a qualified and registered voter of the State who wants to vote by mail in either **Moorestown Fire District No. 1** or **Moorestown Fire District No. 2** regular annual election to be held on **Saturday, February 15, 2020** the following applies:

You must complete the application form and send it to the county clerk where you reside or write or apply in person to the county clerk where you reside to request a mail-in ballot. The name, address, and signature of any person who has assisted you to complete the mail-in ballot application must be provided on the application, and you must sign and date the application.

No person may serve as an authorized messenger or bearer for more than three qualified voters in an election.

No person who is a candidate in the election for which the voter requests a mail-in ballot may provide any assistance in the completion of the ballot or serve as an authorized messenger or bearer.

A person who applies for a mail-in ballot must submit his or her application at least seven days before the election, but such person may request an application in person from the county clerk up to 3 p.m. of the day before the election.

Voters who want to vote by mail in all future elections will, after their initial request and without further action on their part, be provided with a mail-in ballot until the voter requests otherwise in writing.

Application forms may be obtained by applying to the undersigned either in writing or by telephone, or the application form can be found on the Moorestown Fire District No. 1 website at www.moorestownfire.org and the Moorestown Fire District No. 2 website at www.moorestownfire2.com.




